Return to Public Mass (Reduced Capacity)

1. Again, we re-iterate that this is a partial return and Parishioners should not see this as a return to normal Mass attendance. The health and safety of all parishioners is most important, so strict guidelines are in place for

re-opening. All parishioners have a personal responsibility to ensure a safe and comfortable re-opening.

2. It is most important that people who are vulnerable or unwell, and especially those with any symptoms that might suggest Covid-19 infection, should stay at home and, if possible, participate, as now, via webcam, social media, television, or radio. The same applies to those who have been in recent contact with someone who has the virus, in accordance with public health advice.

3. The wearing of face coverings is advisable. Everyone will enter through the front door of the church and exit after Mass through the side door. Stewards will be on hand to assist parishioners. There will be a queuing system and parishioners will be guided to available seats.

4. Please use the gel dispensers provided and minimise the risk of infection by touching church furniture as little as possible.

5. Holy Communion will only be distributed after Mass in a seat-by-seat manner and Parishioners will exit after receiving Communion. Communion will be distributed to the hands only and you are asked not to congregate at the doors or in car park. Those attending Mass in the car park may receive Holy Communion in the church after Mass.

6. There will be collection points for Offerings/envelopes at the entrance and exits of the church. Please ensure that you bring all personal items with you after Mass

7. Everything is being done to ensure the health and wellbeing of parishioners. We expect there will be teething problems, but we appreciate your co-operation and understanding as we bid to return safely to Mass and public worship.
