Celebrating Holy Week: The Catholic faith is anchored in Holy Week.

Without Jesus' Passion, Death and Resurrection - the central mystery of our faith - we would not have a path to eternal life. To arrive at the joy of Easter, we must first travel through the suffering that preceded it. Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday and continues through the Triduum (3 days) from Holy Thursday to Good Friday, Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday.

The 'Pilgrim Passport' Is a bespoke booklet that encourages visitors to embark on a spiritual journey across Ireland, exploring a rich Christian heritage and reliving the pilgrim tradition that has been a rich heritage documented back to medieval times. By visiting each of the three iconic pilgrimage sites – Croagh Patrick and Knock Shrine, both in County Mayo, and Lough Derg in County Donegal – pilgrims can get their passport stamped, serving as a poignant reminder of their journey.
